About the Crowne Plaza Houston Hotel – Reliant Park

Formally named the Grand Plaza Hotel, the [Crowne Plaza Houston - Reliant Park](#) (Kirby at 610) is now part of the Crowne Plaza brand after undergoing a \$10 million dollar renovation. In this move, the hotel becomes one of the freshest and largest hotels in the city, with more than 650 sleeping rooms and suites and 85,000 square feet of meeting space. The Ballroom is over 17,000 square feet!

A hotel filled with Houston history and lore, it opened in 1969 and was completed in 1970; the AstroWorld Hotel, as it was then known, was the pinnacle of the late Judge Roy Hofheinz's AstroDomain Complex. His prized AstroWorld Hotel was immediately revered as the hot spot of Houston. From his spacious residence occupying much of the hotel's top floor, appropriately dubbed the Celestial Suite, the Judge could look out over his domain, which included AstroWorld and the famed Astrodome stadium. At one time, The Guinness Book of World Records listed the hotel's Celestial Suite as the most expensive hotel suite in the world.
